Teachers will not be available during this time.

Back-to-School Shopping: We know a lot of you are school shopping, so please remember to buy outfits that fit within the school dress code. The full dress code can be found in the student handbook, but here are the basics.

- No hats or hoods can be worn in the building.
- Students' upper garments must completely cover shoulders, cleavage and midriffs when students are standing, sitting, or reaching overhead.
- Students' lower garments must extend to at least the upper thigh when sitting, standing, or reaching.
- Clothing and accessories should not include obscene, violent, gang, tobacco, drug or alcohol related writing or images. Items should not have writing or images that are vulgar, offensive, libelous, or promote intolerance or confrontation.

Backpacks

- If students wish to carry backpacks during the day (between classes) they must be clear (not mesh) backpacks.
- Students can bring other backpacks TO school, but they need to be kept in their lockers.
