It's time to begin planning our Educational Travel Program to Washington, D.C. / Gettysburg. The tour dates for our trip will be May 26-29, 2022. This is an excellent opportunity for students to visit the hub of our American heritage and government. Our staff will chaperone the tour which will be arranged by Classic Student Tours, a local agency that specializes in Educational Student Travel Programs (www.classicstudenttours.com).

The cost of the travel program per student, based on quad occupancy and the following number of paying persons per motor coach is only:

A <u>deposit of \$200.00</u> (\$75.00 of which is non-refundable) and a <u>completed parental permission form</u> are <u>due</u> to the company by <u>Tuesday, January 11, 2022</u>, to hold your reservation. Deposits received after one motor coach is filled will be accepted to form a waiting list for additional motor coaches, or replacement of canceled reservations. A <u>second payment of \$200.00</u> is due by <u>Tuesday, February 8, 2022</u>. A <u>third payment of \$200.00</u> is due by <u>Tuesday, March 8, 2022</u>. The <u>balance</u>, which will be determined by the number of students per motor coach as indicated above, is <u>due</u> by <u>Tuesday, April 5, 2022</u>.
